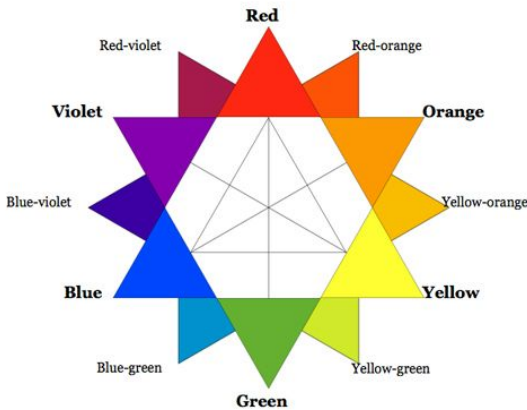


Color Choices



- red : passion, anger, importance (red carpet)
 - orange : vibrance, energy, autumn, earth, health, hunger (McD)
 - yellow : happiness, sunshine, deceit/cowardice, hope, danger
 - green : earth, growth, new beginnings, envy/jealousy, lack of experience, harmony, affluence (dark green = money)
 - blue : sadness, calm, responsibility, refreshment, peace
 - purple : royalty, creativity/imagination, romance
 - black/white/grey/brown : backdrops to be combined with brighter accents, or alone for “sophisticated” layouts.
- colors may have other significance in other cultures!!

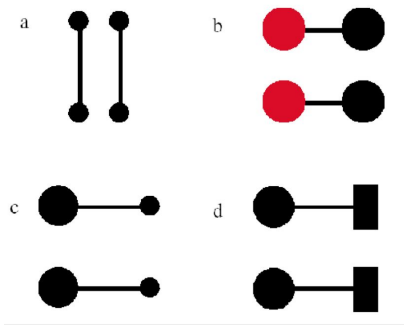
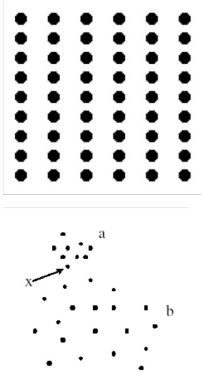
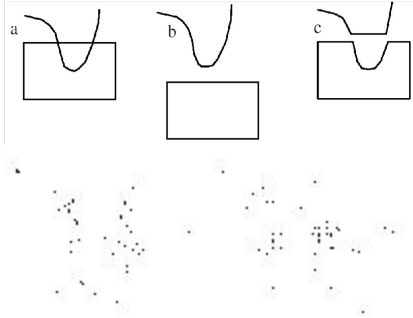
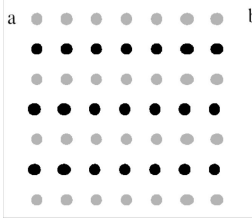
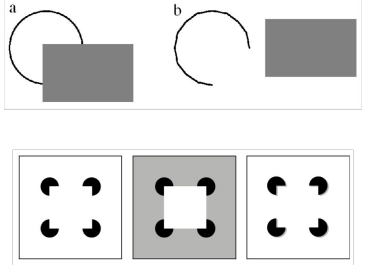
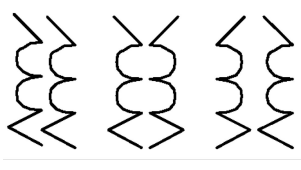

Typography

- workhorse typefaces are like comfy jeans: go with everything, adapt to surroundings to become more relaxed/formal as needed, and are worn day after day. usually, these have many weights (Light, Regular, Bold, etc) and/or cuts (Italic, Condensed, etc)
- font classes : geometric, humanist sans, old style, transitional/modern, slab serif
- when choosing fonts: *keep it exactly the same or change it a lot.*
 - typefaces can work together if they have exactly one thing in common
 - visual (similar x-height or stroke weight)
 - chronological (typefaces from same time likely to work well together)
- use funky fonts as accents, not as body text
- there are no rules : there are only conventions
